
DID YOU KNOW?


- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you a strong Right of Privacy, enjoy it and protect it
- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you a strong Right-to-Know what your government is doing including open meetings and records – take advantage of it and protect it
- Your Montana Constitution is the only constitution that guarantees you the Right to Participate in your government before decisions are made – use it and protect it
- Your Montana Constitution provides you a constitutional right to a Clean & Healthful Environment enjoy it and protect it
- Your Montana Constitution requires All Votes in the Legislature to be Publically Recorded so you'll know what
 your legislators are doing.
- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you a Right to Keep & Bear Arms that is stronger than the US Constitution
- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you a Right to Vote that is stronger than the US Constitution
- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you an independent & non-partisan Judiciary (court system)
- Your Montana Constitution guarantees you the right to vote on another Constitutional Convention every 20
 years, the next time in 2030
- Your Montana Constitution Protects MT's hunting & fishing heritage
- Under your Montana Constitution all state lands are held in trust for the people of Montana
- Under your Montana Constitution the state government must maintain a balanced budget
- Your Montana Constitution requires a **balanced independent citizen commission** to redraw our legislative district lines every 10 years.
